Directions to the West Grounds (Check in Station)

From the Arsenal Road exit continue to the top of the ramp and turn left (west) onto the s/w frontage road of Interstate 55. Continue left (south) until you reach the stop sign (Blodgett Road). Turn right onto Blodgett and continue approximately ½ mile, turning left onto River Road. Continue approximately ¼ mile to the West Grounds. The check in station is the northern most building in the parking lot on the left.

The state of Illinois requires all participants of a Hunting Test and Field Trial to carry a valid hunting license and habitat stamp. This included gunners, handlers and scouts. The law does not apply to non-residents who wish to participate in these events. The sponsoring club will obtain a waiver of license for non-resident participants.

Eligibility and Risk

Open to all pointing breeds in good standing with the AKC. AKC registered dogs must be 6 months of age or older on the event date. ILP/PAL dogs are eligible to participate. Bitches in season are not eligible and are not allowed on the grounds (entry fees will be refunded after providing a veterinary certification to the Hunting Test Secretary). Dogs are ineligible to enter a test if the test's Judge or Judge's family member has owned, sold, leased, boarded, trained or handled the dog within one year of the test date. Owners or handlers entering a test do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them or their dogs.
